## Uniform Policy

## **General**

It is expected that all children will dress smartly in our school uniform as it encourages them to take pride in their school and their own appearance. Following the Easter break, children may wear summer uniform.

Children have the freedom to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in or that reflects their self-identified gender.

## **School Uniform for Years R-6**

- Grey skirt, pinafore dress, school trousers or school shorts/skorts
- Grey/black tights (preferably not for KS1), grey or white socks
- Burgundy school jumper or cardigan with school logo – available from Goyals
- White buttoned school shirt – Year 1-6
- School tie – Year 1-6 – available from Goyals
- White polo shirt for Reception
- Sensible black school shoes
- Hijabs in the school burgundy colour, black or white. Worn tucked under the shirt collar if possible so that the school tie is visible
- Plain headbands should also be in the school burgundy colour, black or white
- Hair accessories should be plain and in school colours with no additional embellishments such as bows or flowers
- No nail varnish/temporary tattoos

## **Summer Term**

Children have the option to wear the following during this term:

- Burgundy checked dress
- White polo shirts (without logos)
- School sun hat/white sun hat

## **PE Kit –**

Black jogging bottoms and black shorts (no logos/cycling shorts or leggings)

- Burgundy PE top with logo – available from Goyals
- Dark trainers suitable for sport

Extra uniform is not required when representing the school. Should there be an event which requires different clothing, the school will provide it.

## **Swimming**

- Swimming costume/trunks
- Towel
- Swimming cap
- Goggles

Children may request changes to swimwear for religious reasons

### **School Uniform for Nursery**

School uniform is not compulsory for Nursery children, however it is recommended and is usually a white polo shirt, black jogging bottoms and school jumper. This encourages them to feel part of the school and its identity.

### **Jewellery**

- Plain stud earrings may be worn but for health and safety reasons, they must be removed or taped over for P.E.
- Other jewellery should not be worn for school unless it is for religious reasons and the Head has been informed by the parents

### **Hair**

Long hair should be tied back with a black or burgundy hair tie. Patterns and fashionable cut lines in haircuts considered extreme by the school should be kept for the longer holidays.

### **Second hand uniform**

The school family are encouraged to donate any good quality outgrown uniform where it can be passed on to other families to reuse.

The school always aim to support any families who need to apply to charities for funding towards uniform costs unless we have pre-owned uniform in stock.

### **Additional uniform**

Families are encouraged to use a Larchfield branded book bag rather than a rucksack as we have limited space. Any other uniform requests will be addressed on a case by case basis at the Headteacher's discretion.
