Welcome to the Autumn Term!

TIMES OF THE SCHOOL DAY

- The school day begins at 8.30am to 8.45am. Children come in through main gate and KS1 door. The school day finishes at 3.15pm with children being collected and exiting via the main gate.

ILLNESS

- If your child is ill, please telephone the school by 8:30am on the first day of illness.

READING AND SPELLING

- Each child has been sent home with a purple reading folder including a decodable book, reading record and reminder about importance of reading.
- This folder must come into school **EVERYDAY**. New books will be given out each **FRIDAY**.
- Please read with your child and comment in their reading record **at least 4x a week**.
- Spellings will be handed out each Wednesday, to be practiced 5x a week, and tested the following Wednesday.

HOME LEARNING

- Your child can earn house points by completing the Home Learning Grid. Well done to those that made a head start over the Summer Holidays.

APPOINTMENTS

- We are always happy to talk with you about your child. If you wish to make an appointment, please contact the school office.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- We would also like to remind you of the importance of regular attendance at school. If a child is absent for a period of time, there will be gaps in their learning, which may cause difficulties in the future. Holidays will not be authorised.

UNIFORM

- I've been impressed with how smart Year 1 looks. **Year 1 uniform consists of a shirt and a tie. Please note polo shirts are NOT part of Year 1 uniform.**
