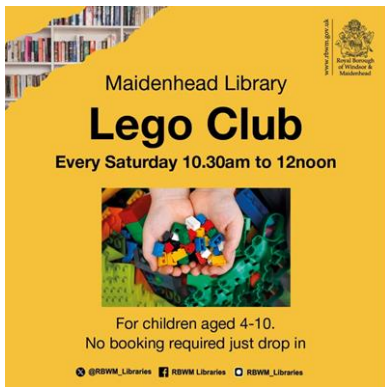


Thank you to all our lovely Mummies who managed to get to our Mothers' Day Tea this week.
