Well done, Year 5. A great assembly, there was so many last minute changes that the children rose to the challenge to share everything they had learnt this term. Great job, Year 5!

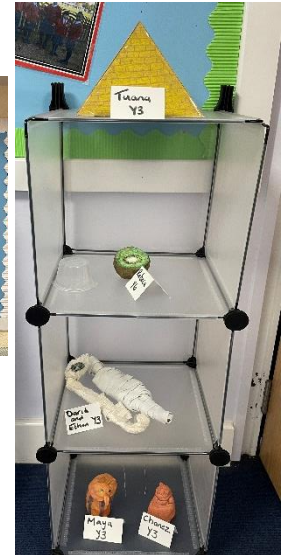
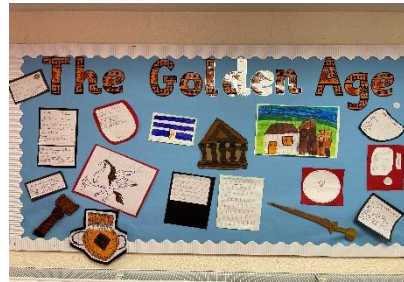
Nursery getting down to starting to write and Reception doing so much thinking in RE this week, they needed a lie down!

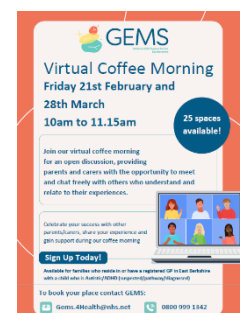
