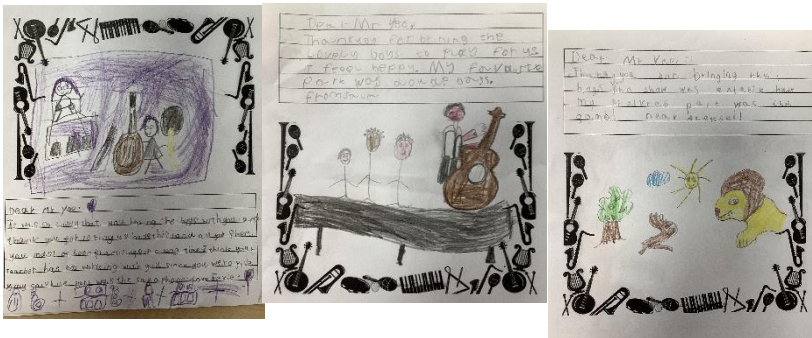


'Be the family you want'

It has looked like we are growing a new breed of Dentists in Reception. They are being all scientific and even learning about 'dribbling!' 😊

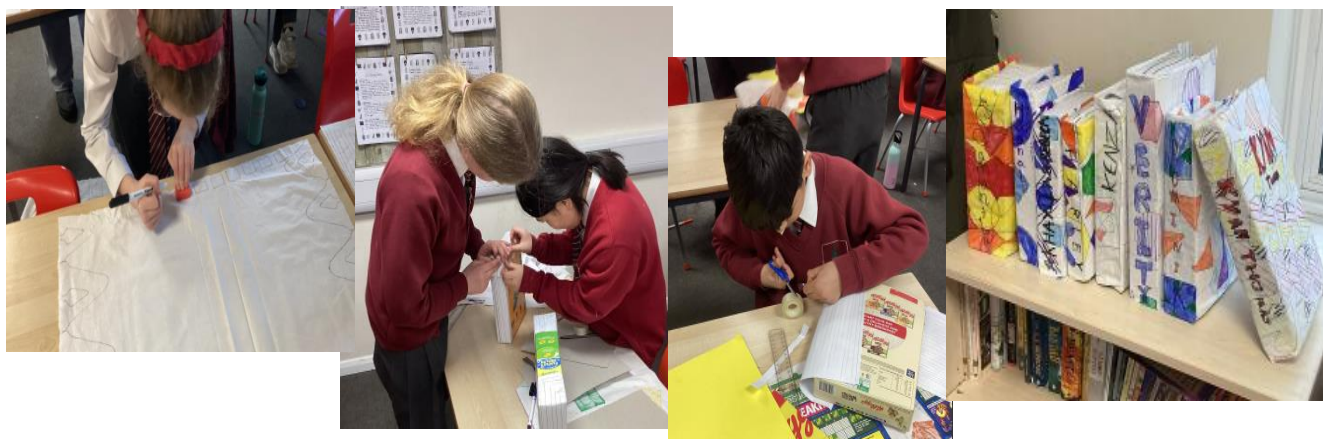
