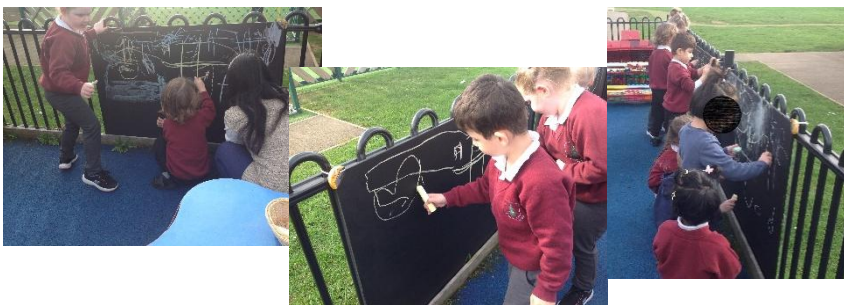
Dear Parents and Care givers,

Our theme for the week is – Neurodiversity Celebration Week

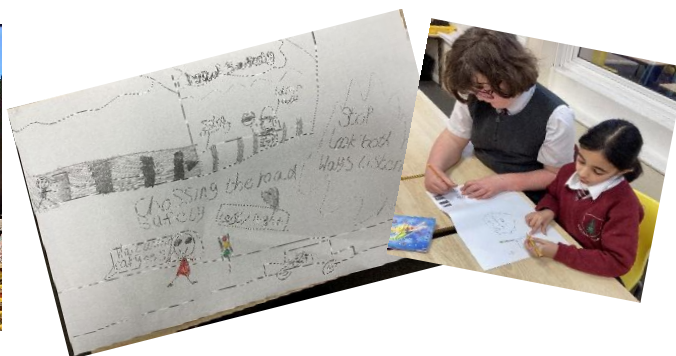
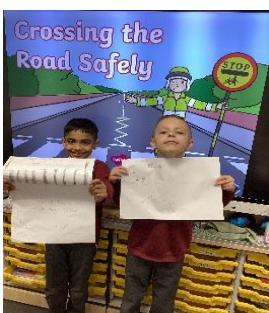
Our music focus of the week is – Fats Domino - Jazz

These are the parts of our uniform which are being replaced by non-uniform items by families:

- **White shirts**, not polo shirts, unless in Nursery or Reception
- **Ties** must be worn unless in Nursery or Reception
- **Dark grey school trousers** or shorts, not black
- **Black/plain joggers** for PE, not leggings of any sort
- Black PE shorts, no other options

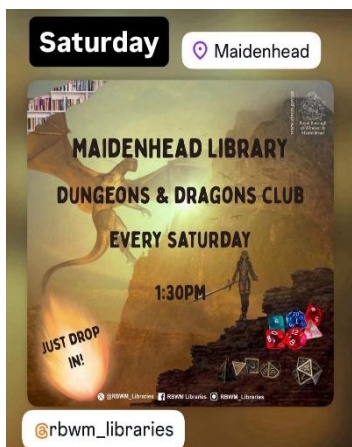
Please also note we **do not** have plimsoles as part of the school uniform, it is black shoes for uniform and trainers for PE.
