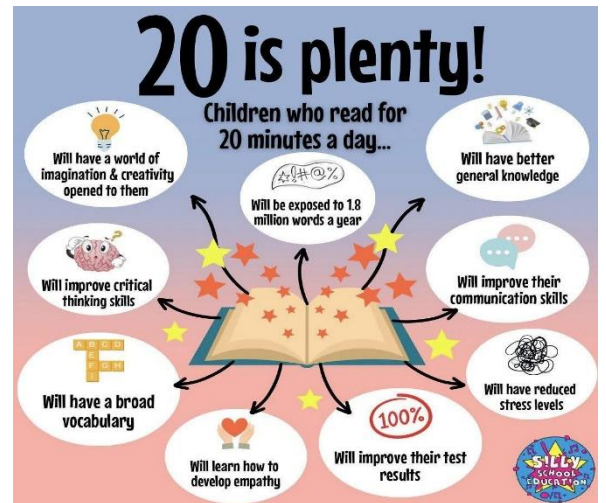
Dear Parents and Care givers,

Music genre for the Week – Bob Marley – Reggae – 1970s

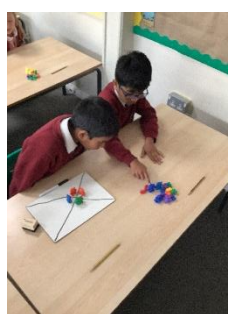
