We decided again that we couldn't have Y5 camp, we have a last ditched attempt on 16/17th July.

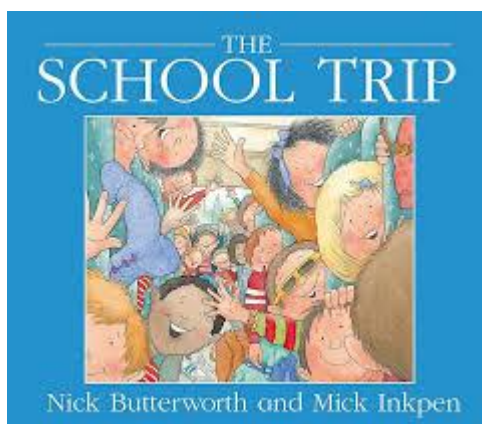
